Places to eat & drink

- George Kenyon Building – Greenhouse Café
- University Place – The Market, Veggie Place, Potato Shack
- Oxford Road, next to St Peter's House Chaplaincy – Milk and Honey Café
- Oxford Road, opposite and to the right of University Place – A number of outlets on University Green, including Café Nero (inside Blackwell's), Mowgli Street Food and Five Guys.
- Oxford Road, within the Manchester Museum – Coffee bar

Places to visit

- University of Manchester Museum - opposite University Place, Oxford Road.
- Whitworth Art Gallery, Oxford Rd, Manchester M15 6ER. Turn left from University Place along Oxford Road and take a 10 minute walk to reach destination, or 2 stops on the 142/143/42 bus.
- Local shops include Co-Op convenience store and Blackwell's Book Shop - Oxford Road, opposite and to the right of University Place.

If you would like to go into the city centre, buses run every couple of minutes to Piccadilly Gardens bus station. Buses that will get you there and back include 142, 143 & 42.
